AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 48202(a)(4) OF CHAPTER 48, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, ADDING THE RESPONSIBILITY OF GARBAGE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL TO THE LANDLORD IN THE GUAM LANDLORD AND TENANT RENTAL ACT OF 2018.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds 3 that illegal dumping is a major issue on the island.
- I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds that a portion of the illegal dumping is attributed to tenants residing in dwelling units wherein the landlord or property owner is not mandated by law to provide garbage service.
- I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to require landlords or property owners renting
 all types of dwelling units to provide for garbage storage and removal service.
- 9 **Section 2.** A new §48202(a)(4) is hereby *added* to Chapter 48, of Title 21,
- 10 Guam Code Annotated, to read:

1	"(4) provide and maintain appropriate receptacles and conveniences					
2	for the removal of garbage, rubbish, and other waste incidental to the					
3	occupancy of the dwelling unit and arrange for their removal."					
4	Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.					
5	Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to					
6	any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity					
7	shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect					
8	without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this					
9	Act are severable.
