## AN ACT TO *ADD* § 1905(b)(3) TO ARTICLE 9, OF CHAPTER 1, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING APPROPRIATIONS OR PAYMENTS TO THE PACIFIC ISLANDS DEVELOPMENT BANK (PIDB) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021 AND 2022.

<b>BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:</b>								
Section 1. A new § 1905(b)(3) is hereby <i>added</i> to Article 9, of Chapter 1,								
Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:								
§ 1905. Authorization of Appropriation and Payment of Subscription.								
(a) One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) are authorized to be								
appropriated, without fiscal year limitations, for the purchase of one								
thousand (1,000) shares of capital stock in the Bank;								
(b) The Governor, on behalf of the government of Guam, shall:								
(1) make payment of an initial subscription to the additional								
capital stock of the Bank of a sum equivalent to One Hundred								
Thousand Dollars USD (\$100,000 USD) in accordance with the terms								
of the Agreement; and								
(2) subject to appropriation by the Legislature, make any								
additional payments which may become payable under the Agreement								
to purchase the shares under Subitem (a) of this § 1905.								

1"(3) notwithstanding any other provisions of the law, no2appropriations or payments shall be made for the purposes stated in3Article 9 of this Chapter for Fiscal Year's 2021 and 2022."

4 Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to 5 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such 6 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be 7 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 8 provisions of this Act are severable.

9 Section 3. Effective Date. The Act *shall* become effective immediately
10 upon enactment.
