AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE MILLION FIVE **HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000) FROM** 2021 EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT REIMBURSEMENT TO **DEPARTMENT** THE OF **PUBLIC** WORKS FOR THE **PURPOSE** OF CONSTRUCTING A **SOUTHERN EMERGENCY** ACCESS BOAT RAMP IN TALO'FO'FO' TO PROVIDE **EMERGENCY** SAFE MARINE ACCESS FOR PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.
- 3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that for years, access to the southeastern part of
- 4 Guam's ocean is dangerous and inaccessible due to the unavailability of an adequate
- 5 boat ramp.
- 6 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the absence of a boat ramp causes
- 7 delay for fire, conservation and other officials to respond to marine incidents in the
- 8 vicinity and that the availability of an access boat ramp will significantly improve
- 9 response times for personnel when responding to incidents.
- 10 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the federal government authorized
- reimbursements for Guam in the Earned Income Tax Credit program in 2021.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* appropriate One Million
Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) from the 2021 Earned Income Tax
Credit program reimbursement to the Department of Public Works to construct a
southern emergency access boat ramp in *Talo'fo'fo'* to provide safe marine access
for emergency personnel.

Section 2. Appropriation to the Department of Public Works. The sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) from the revenues received pursuant to Chapter 42 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, the Earned Income Program, reimbursement for calendar year 2021, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing a southern emergency access boat ramp in *Talo'fo'fo'*. This appropriation shall not lapse and shall continue to be available until fully expended.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall be effective immediately upon enactment.
