AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT TO USE LAPSE FUNDS FROM FY 2019 TO BE USED FOR OPERATIONAL EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Continuing Appropriation Authorized. Notwithstanding any other 2 provision of law, the unexpended balance of funds appropriated to the Guam Police 3 Department from the Police Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund in the amount of eighty-4 one thousand Seven hundred forty-four dollars and fifty-one cents (\$81,744.51) in 5 Fiscal year 2020, and two hundred thirteen thousand seven hundred three dollars and 6 twenty-four cents (\$213,703.24) from the Safe Schools Initiative for Fiscal Year 7 2020 shall not lapse and shall continue to be available for any purpose until fully 8 9 expended. Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment. 10 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any 11 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions 12 or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or 13

14 application and to this end the provisions of this Act is severable.
