**AN ACT TO ADD § 77136 TO CHAPTER 77 OF TITLE
10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
PROHIBITING THE FUNDING OF EXECUTIVE
SECURITY FROM THE BUDGET OF THE GUAM
POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 77136 is hereby *added* to Chapter 77 of Title 10, Guam
Code Annotated, to read as follows:

**“§ 77136. Prohibiting the Funding of Executive Security to be Funded
from the Budget Appropriated to the Guam Police Department.**

Notwithstanding any other provisions of the law, rule, or regulation to the
contrary, no funds from the budget appropriated to the Guam Police Department,
in any fiscal year, shall be utilized to budget the Executive Security provided to the
Executive Branch of Guam, pursuant to Chapters 1 and 2 of Title 5, Guam Code
Annotated. This subsection shall also apply to the expenses associated with the
purchase or lease of any vehicles or resources used, off island travel, or any
overtime expenses incurred, all for the purposes of providing Executive Security to
the Executive Branch, pursuant to Chapters 1 and 2 of Title 5, Guam Code
Annotated.”

1 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
2 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
3 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be
4 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
5 provisions of this Act are severable.

6 **Section 3. Effective Date.** The Act *shall* become effective on October 1,
7 2021.
