AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ITEM (d) TO § 70126 OF TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXEMPTIONS FOR BUSINESS LICENSES; AND, TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (40) TO § 26203 OF TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAXES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new item (d) is added to § 70126 of Title 11, Guam Code

3 Annotated, to read:

4 "(d) Each artist listed by the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities in
5 its Artist Directory."

6 Section 2. Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities (GCAHA) to 7 provide certification. The GCAHA shall certify that the artist seeking an 8 exemption, as authorized by Section 1 of this Act, is currently listed in its Artist 9 Directory. The GCAHA shall update its Artist Directory quarterly to ensure the 10 proper status of each artist at the time certification is requested.

Section 3. Exemption from Payment of Business Privilege Taxes. A new subsection (40) is added to § 26203 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

"(40) Amounts received from the sale of locally-produced visual art by
persons or entities certified as listed in the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities
Artist Directory. For this subsection's purposes, "visual arts" are art forms such as
ceramics, drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, design, crafts, photography,
video, filmmaking, literature, and architecture."

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Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
