AN ACT TO AMEND § 83102(d) AND ADD A NEW § 83116, TO CHAPTER 83, ALL OF TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO INCREASING PUBLIC NOTICE AND TRANSPARENCY OF THE ACTIONS BY THE GUAM TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY HEALTHCARE CENTER COMMITTEE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE **PROPOSED MEDICAL HEALTHCARE CAMPUS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the policy statement in the Open 4 Government Law in 5 GCA Chapter 8 states, "The Legislature declares it is the policy of this Territory that the formation of public policy and decisions is 5 public and shall not be conducted in secret. The people of Guam do not yield 6 7 their individual rights to the public agencies which serve them. The people, in delegating authority, do not give their public servants the right to decide what 8 is good for the people to know and what is not good for them to know. The 9 people insist on remaining informed so that they may retain control over the 10 instruments they have created." 11

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that Public Law 36-56 authorized the Government of Guam to enter into a contract for the design, build, finance, 13 lease, transfer and long-term capital maintenance of the Guam Twenty-First 14

Century Healthcare Center with private sector contractors who can provide
 long-term financing. The construction of the proposed medical healthcare
 campus is currently estimated to cost \$1 billion dollars.

It is the intent of the *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ensure the people of Guam,
medical providers, and the Legislature are informed of the meetings, actions,
and decisions surrounding the design, lease, and financing of the proposed
medical healthcare campus by making Guam Twenty-First Century Healthcare
Committee meetings subject to the Open Government Law.

Section 2. § 83102(d) of Chapter 83, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended, to read:

'Guam Twenty-First Century Healthcare Center Committee' "(d) 11 shall be chaired by Administrator or Deputy Administrator of the Guam 12 Economic Development Authority and include the Administrator and 13 Directors of all Healthcare Agencies, the Director or Deputy Director of 14 Department of Public Works, the Director or Deputy Director of Department 15 16 of Land Management, the Director or Deputy Director of the Bureau of Statistics and Planning, the Director or Deputy Director of the Bureau of 17 Budget Management and Research, and Director or Deputy Director of the 18 Department of Administration, President of the Guam Medical Society or 19 their designee, and President of the Guam Medical Association or their 20 designee." 21

Section 3. A new § 83116 is hereby added to Chapter 83 of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"<u>§ 83116. Public Notices of Guam Twenty-First Century</u> Healthcare Center Committee meetings.

(a) All meetings, including working meetings and 1 subcommittee meetings of the Guam Twenty-First Century 2 Healthcare Center Committee shall be subject to the Open 3 Government Law pursuant to 5 GCA Chapter 8 and the public shall 4 be allowed to attend. It is intended that the Guam Medical 5 Association and the Guam Medical Society shall notify their 6 members of meetings via email. 7 (b) All meeting minutes shall be posted on the Guam 8 Economic Development Authority website, the audio recording of 9 each meeting shall be provided to the Office of Public 10 Accountability within seven (7) calendar days after the meeting, and 11 electronic copies of the meeting agendas, minutes, and other 12 attachments and addendums as discussed in each meeting shall be 13 provided to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than 14

15 <u>fifteen (15) day after the meeting.</u>"

16 Section 4. Severability. The provisions outlined in this Act are declared to 17 be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph, 18 subdivision, section or portion of this statute, or the invalidity of the application 19 thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of the remainder 20 of this statute or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.
