AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §9117 TO ARTICLE 1,  
CHAPTER 9, TITLE 12 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED  
RELATIVE TO TRANSFERRING CONTROL OF THE  
TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND GRANTS PROGRAM TO  
THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GUAM VISITORS  
BUREAU.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** A new §9117 is *added* to Article 1, Chapter 9, 12 GCA to read as  
follows:

**“§ 9117. Grant Awards Fund and Authority to Award Grants to Organizations.**

There is hereby created the *Guam Visitor’s Bureau Grant Awards Fund* (the Grant  
Fund) that is funded by sources that include, but are not limited to, appropriations  
from *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, federal grants and private donations. The Board of  
Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau may solicit for and receive grant applications  
and proposals from governmental and non-governmental organizations and may  
allocate the Grant Fund balances in each Fiscal Year to Categories One and Two as  
follows:

**Category One** (The total funds allocated to Category One shall not exceed fifty  
percent (50%) of the fund balance and revenues available each fiscal year.):

(a) The Department of Parks and Recreation

(b) The Mayors Council of Guam

(c) Individual Mayoral offices or Municipal Planning Councils

**Category Two** (The total funds allocated to Category Two shall not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the fund balance and revenues available each fiscal year.):

(a) *På'å Taotao Tåno'*;

(b) Historic *Inalåhan* Foundation;

(c) Pacific War Museum Foundation;

(d) *Håya* Cultural Preservation Foundation;

(e) Guam International Film Festival;

(f) *Humåtak* Foundation

(g) *Åmot Taotao Tåno'*;

(h) *Huråo* Academy, Inc.;

(i) *Inetnon Gefpa'go* Cultural Arts Program, Inc.;

(j) Humanities *Guåhan*;

(k) Guam Symphony Society;

(l) Guam Unique Merchandise and Arts (GUMA);

(m) *Duk Duk* Goose, Inc.;

(n) *Ayuda* Foundation;

(o) Traditions Affirming our Seafaring Ancestry (TASA);

(p) Traditions About Seafaring Islands (TASI);

(q) *Guåfi*, Inc.;

(r) University of Guam Press;

(s) *Ulita*o; or

(t) Micronesian Conservation Trust.

(u) Any other non-profit organization as determined by the Board."
