## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1

- Section 1. A new §9117 is added to Article 1, Chapter 9, 12 GCA to read as 2

- "§ 9117. Grant Awards Fund and Authority to Award Grants to Organizations. 4
- There is hereby created the Guam Visitor's Bureau Grant Awards Fund (the Grant 5
- Fund) that is funded by sources that include, but are not limited to, appropriations 6
- from I Liheslaturan Guåhan, federal grants and private donations. The Board of 7
- Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau may solicit for and receive grant applications 8
- and proposals from governmental and non-governmental organizations and may 9
- allocate the Grant Fund balances in each Fiscal Year to Categories One and Two as 10
