AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ATKILÓN GUMA' ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (AGA) FOR THE CREATION OF A GRANT PROGRAM TO ASSIST ELIGIBLE FAMILIES WITH RENTAL ASSISTANCE; AND TO CITE THIS ACT AS THE "ATKILÓN GUMA' ASSISTANCE ACT OF 2021."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
that the global pandemic expressed the need for the government of Guam to
establish local programs to assist struggling families during times of uncertainties.
As thousands of island residents experienced furloughs or reduced hours at work,
necessities for families, such as making home rental payments became (becomes)
more challenging.

8 This economic crisis brought by the pandemic is expected to escalate at least 9 for the rest of 2021, hence many families may face evictions in the process. With 10 the infusion of additional federal support being provided to Guam, a local program 11 can be established with adequate funding for eligible families, which could be 12 extended beyond this year. Further, the funds would help provide additional

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1	support for landlords, of which they may have mortgage obligations, and could
2	also face foreclosures.
3	Section 2. This Act shall be known as the "Atkilon Guma' Assistance Act of
4	2021."
5	Section 3. Establishment of the Atkilon Guma' Assistance Program
6	(AGA).
7	(a) The Atkilon Guma' Assistance Program (AGA) is hereby
8	established by this Act.
9	(b) The President of the Guam Housing Corporation shall administer
10	the AGA Program.
11	(c) Eligible applicants for the AGA Program <i>shall be</i> as follows:
12	(1) A United States Citizen or a legally residing resident; and
13	(2) The applicant <i>shall</i> be a Guam Resident in 2020; and
14	(3) The income eligibility requirements shall be based on 2019
15	adjusted gross income, and as follows:
16	(A) An individual shall have earned under \$75,000; and
17	(B)Those married or filing jointly, the total earnings shall
18	<i>be</i> under \$150,000;
19	; and
20	(4) An eligible individual or head of household for a joint
21	filing, shall have experienced an income loss due to a furlough, or
22	reduced hours at work, at the time of the application, and shall not be
23	availing any federal unemployment benefits as well at the time of the
24	application; and
25	(5) Any other criteria established by the President of the Guam
26	Housing Corporation and adopted by I Liheslaturan Guåhan pursuant
27	to Section 8 of this Act.

1 Section 4. Purpose of the Atkilon Guma' Assistance Program (AGA). 2 (a) The AGA assists qualified households with rental assistance, 3 pursuant to the parameters of eligible applicants defined in Section 3 of this 4 Act. 5 (b) The Guam Housing Corporation is authorized to establish 6 additional criteria, rules and regulations for the AGA Program, inclusive of 7 the application process, and it shall be adopted by I Liheslaturan Guåhan 8 pursuant to Section 8 of this Act. 9 Section 5. Implementation. 10 The Guam Housing Corporation *shall* have thirty (30) working days from 11 the date of identification of funds by I Maga'Hagan Guåhan for the purposes of 12 this Act to implement the Atkilon Guma' Assistance Program. 13 Section 6. Funding. 14 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, or rule or regulation, I 15 Maga'Hagan Guåhan is authorized to transfer up to Five Million Dollars 16 (\$5,000,000), plus any additional amount needed to administrative costs, to the 17 Guam Housing Corporation, for the purposes of this Act, as may be available from 18 the following: 19 (a) Fiscal Year 2021 General Fund appropriations; and 20 (b) Any federal appropriations that can be used for the purposes of 21 this Act. 22 No local funds may be used for this Program if federal funds that can be 23 used for the purposes of this Act are available to encumber, obligate, or expend. 24 Any funds transferred pursuant to this Act *shall* only be used for the purposes of 25 this Act. Payments under this Act shall be required only if payments can be 26 funded under a federal coronavirus relief package or such other federal funds are 27 appropriate and lawful.

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Section 7. Reporting.

Upon lifting of the public health emergency declaration for Guam, the Guam Housing Corporation *shall* submit a report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, which *shall* include the cumulative number of applicants assisted, the total amount of the funds issued, the total administrative costs to facilitate this Act, and the authorized amounts transferred by *I Maga'Hagan Guåhan* under Section 6 of this Act.

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Section 8. Rules and Regulations.

9 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* hereby adopts the Rules and Regulations pursuant to 10 Sections 3 and 4 of this Act. Notwithstanding any provision of the Guam 11 Administrative Adjudication Law, the President of the Guam Housing Corporation, 12 *shall*, within thirty (30) days of the enactment of this Act, promulgate additional 13 rules and regulations not stipulated in this Act to implement the *Atkilòn Guma'* 14 *Assistance Program*, and *shall* transmit such rules and regulations to the Speaker 15 of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for further adoption.

16 Section 9. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to 17 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such 18 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be 19 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 20 provisions of this Act are severable.

21 Section 10. Effective Date. The Act *shall* become effective upon
22 enactment.
