**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 5141(n) TO CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5 AND TO ADD A NEW § 1924 TO CHAPTER 19, TITLE 1, BOTH OF GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AGENCIES SUBMITTING A PROCUREMENT COMPLIANCE REPORT TO THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTABILITY.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds through the conclusion and recommendations of OPA Report No. 20-09, Government of Guam Procurement Training and Certification Follow-up Audit, there is no entity monitoring agency compliance with the procurement training.

*I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to follow said reports recommendations by having all agencies submit a procurement compliance report to the Office of Public Accountability.

**Section 2.** A new § 5141(n) is hereby *added* to Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

“(n) Procurement Compliance Report.

(1) Timeline for Submission. No later than thirty (30) days after the end of each fiscal year, every director, administrator, president or head of a government of Guam agency, including line agencies, autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies, public corporations, the Guam Mayor’s Council, the Courts of the Judiciary of Guam and I

2 *electronic format (via .pdf e-mail attachment), a “Procurement*  
3 *Compliance Report.”*

4 *(2) Content Guidelines. Said report shall summarize*  
5 *procurement training compliance of employees responsible for*  
6 *procurement.”*

7 **Section 3.** A new § 1924 is hereby *added* to Chapter 19, Title 1, Guam Code  
8 Annotated, to read as follows:

9 **“§ 1924. Procurement Compliance Report.**

10 *The Public Auditor of Guam shall receive and maintain a*  
11 *“Procurement Compliance Report”, in electronic format (via .pdf e-*  
12 *mail attachment), which shall summarize procurement training*  
13 *compliance of employees responsible for procurement. No later than*  
14 *thirty (30) days after the end of each fiscal year, every director,*  
15 *administrator, president or head of a government of Guam agency,*  
16 *including line agencies, autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies,*  
17 *public corporations, the Guam Mayor’s Council, the Courts of the*  
18 *Judiciary of Guam and I Liheslaturan Guåhan, shall submit said report*  
19 *to the Public Auditor of Guam.”*

20 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
21 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*  
22 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without  
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
24 severable.
