- 2 Section 1. A new Item (D), relative to cannabis content in edible cannabis
- 3 products, is added to § 40109(2) of Chapter 40 (Guam Food, Drug and Cosmetic
- 4 Act), Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

1	"(D) Except that cannabis infused products or cannabis products

4	Section 2. A new Item (6), relative to cannabis content in cosmetic

26	Samples of food, drink and other substances may be taken and

The Director may condemn and forbid the sale of, or cause to be seized, removed or destroyed any food or drink which is unwholesome or adulterated, except that cannabis infused products or cannabis products which are processed, manufactured, labeled, and/or sold by an establishment shall not be considered adulterated solely on the basis of its cannabis content."

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
