BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a proclamation which designated May 15 as "National Peace Officers Memorial Day" and the week in which that date falls as "Police Week"; and law enforcement officers from around the world converge on Washington, D.C. to participate in several planned events which honor those that have paid the ultimate sacrifice. The Memorial Service began in 1982 as a gathering in Senate Park of approximately one hundred twenty (120) survivors and supporters of law enforcement; and decades later, the event, more commonly known as "National Police Week," has grown to be a series of events which attracts thousands of survivors and law enforcement officers each year; however, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, "National Police Week" was postponed in May 2021 to October 8-16, 2021; and

WHEREAS, our law enforcement officers build safer and more secure communities, and every single day they put their lives on the line to defend others, facing the threat of violence and danger that may result in injury, disability, or death; and they play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the community of Guam. Over the past year, law enforcement agencies have had to face more obstacles with the COVID-19 pandemic, as they have assisted with government and public health officials in helping to contain the spread of the virus, serving the local community, and maintaining public order; and given the person-to-person spread of COVID-19, law enforcement officers are also at a heightened risk of exposure due to their close contact with members of the public; and

WHEREAS, Guam observes "National Peace Officers Memorial Day" in honor of our law enforcement officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to our community, or have become disabled in the performance of duty; and it is fitting to pay tribute and to honor Conservation Officer Francisco M. Isezaki, Department of Agriculture; Patrolman Francisco D. Taitague, Guam Police Department (GPD); Patrolman Juan M. Santos, GPD; Special Agent Larry D. 


