Håfa Adai Chairman Senator Joe San Agustin and Members of the Committee,

On behalf of the Guam Ethics Commission, respectfully I submit this testimony in <u>support</u> of Bill No. 205-36 (LS). The Commission understands the need to have an impartial and independent legal counsel to support its function of adjudicating ethics related complaints.

In September, the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) provided the following guidance regarding the Commission's intent to obtain legal services. The Commission's enabling statute provided two options to avail of legal services; either legal services be provided by the OAG, or the Commission would employ a full-time staff attorney. The first option presented a conflict-of-interest challenge for the Commission, as officials of the OAG could also be subject to complaints filed with the Commission. The second option is estimated to cost the Commission anywhere between \$70,000 to \$120,000 annually inclusive of benefits. The Commission's FY2022 appropriation is not sufficient to support this estimated cost.

At its September meeting, the Commission discussed and adopted Resolution 2021-003, which respectfully requests the legislature introduce a measure giving the Commission the option to retain legal services. The Commission is grateful to the sponsor of this legislation Sen. Joe San Agustin and respectfully requests support of Bill 205-36 (LS) from this legislative body.

The Virtual Public Hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00 A.M.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Hafa Adai, The Committee on General Government Operation, Appropriation and Housing is now called to order. Today is Monday October 11th the time now is 9 o'clock. Welcome to everyone connected by zoom of those tuning in via television or the YouTube channel. Thank you for your patient and for accommodating the zoom platform while we maintain social distancing mandates. Public notice for this public hearing we're disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday October 4th 2021 and again on Thursday October 7th. Again, the bill will be entertained this morning is Bill Number 205-36 (LS) introduced by myself, AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (8) TO § 15401(a) OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 15, TITLE 4, GUAM

CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE GUAM ETHICS COMMISSION TO RETAIN LEGAL SERVICES.

The rules of conduct for this hearing, is this zoom meeting is hosted by my staff and will mute all zoom participants until called upon. Members of the Committee and or non-committee members will be allowed to pose a question to an individual testifying. Question and testimony shall be confined to the substance or nature of the agenda. Personal inference as to the character or the motive of any Senator or any individual testifying, is NOT permitted. I'd like to acknowledge that my colleagues that have joined me this morning, we have Senator Amanda Shelton, Senator Telo Taitague and Senator Joanne Brown. Thank you, colleagues, for joining this morning I'd like to acknowledge that we have Mr. Jesse Quenga, The Executive Director of the Guam Ethics Commission. Before I ask you to provide an opening your testimony Jesse, I'm gonna go ahead and just read the bill so that everybody and the people of Guam understand what the bill is about. This bill is the right and just that the Guam Ethics Commission shall be an independent and autonomous entity within the Government of Guam with the authority to agitate complaints against Government Officials will be provided the ethical code of conduct. It is essential that the commission is supported by an independent council. Which will adequately address complaints against Public Officials in accordance with local laws.

This will promote transparency and accountability within our island to maintain good governance. Bill 205 allows for the authorization commission to retain legal services in support of its operation hearing adjudicating ethics complaints against government officials. I look forward to hearing testimonies in today's hearing and I appreciate your participation Si Yu'os Ma'ase and Mr. Quenga, I will ask you to, I'd like to recognize Senator Brown, I think I recognized you earlier that you're here, thank you for joining us. Mr. Quenga if you would go ahead and begin with, state your name, your position and then please begin your testimony.

Jesse John Quenga, Executive Director, Guam Ethics Commission: Right, thank you, *Hafa Adai* and good morning, Chairman Senators San Agustin, Vice Chair Senator Amanda Shelton and Senators Telo Taitague and Joanne Brown. My name is Jesse Quenga, I'm the Executive Director of the Guam Ethics Commission. (See Testimony from Mr Quenga)

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you Mr. Quenga, I'd ask my colleague do you have any questions for Mr. Quenga, starting with Senator Amanda Shelton, ma'am.

Senator Amanda L. Shelton: Thank you very much Mr. Chair, *Hafa Adai* everyone, good morning, thank you for being here for your testimony Mr. Quenga. I just wanted to know if this is something that is budgeted within your existing budget? if you were to this were to pass during this fiscal year is this something that you would already take advantage of?

Jesse John Quenga, Executive Director, Guam Ethics Commission: Thank you for that question, Senator Shelton, the Commission has already done its due diligence so, we initiated some solicitations and found that the average market cost for private attorney is about \$200 an hour. So, factoring that on average if we were to obtain legal services for about 10 hours a month for the duration of the year then there would be funds sufficient. So, thank you very much for asking.

Senator Amanda L. Shelton: Okay, thank you very much, I do understand the need for this type of legislation as uh we've allowed for uh our autonomous or semi-autonomous agencies to do the same to acquire their own legal counsel. And especially, for the Ethics Commission to prevent any type of conflict. So, thank you very much Mr. Chair for this bill and to Mr. Quenga for the testimony today.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you Senator Shelton, Senator Telo Taitague.

Senator Telo T. Taitague: Thank you Mr. Chair, and good morning to my colleagues and good morning to you Jesse, it's good to see you, you know, you've come before us I think, gosh a handful of times on different things trying to piecemeal everything together but I'm glad to see that you're probably on this almost the last leg of what you're trying to accomplish here. And if there's funding that's needed then that's probably the next step, you know, to obtain this attorney if it's not incorporated. However, Jesse when you use the Attorney General's Office, when it's not a conflict of interest, do you pay out of your budget to the Attorney General?

Jesse John Quenga, Executive Director, Guam Ethics Commission: Excellent question Senator Taitague, so, how the arrangement works, is if we're not and supporting their office by cost sharing a particular attorney and then our requests tend to fall in line with all the other requests. So, we raise the risk that these types of legal questions tend to take a while in getting responses back which you're probably quite familiar with so, the alternative that the AG presented us, is that we would have to recruit an attorney and cost share that position. Which would then be directly related to that second option which is quite costly for the Commission to do.

Senator Telo T. Taitague: I see that's good to hear, well you know I'm you know I support this definitely support this you do need that assistance. I mean even with the legislature we need to also look at you know hiring an attorney for our ethics panel as well. My only concern is that Jesse, you know moving forward we need to you know expedite these complaints that come in and not let it linger so long. If there's anything in your bylaws if you have not incorporated, I hope you will that complaints that come in about individuals will be heard and seen and you know uh brought before the panel in 30 days. You know, and addressed these

issues, instead of lingering it on, that's my only concern. And if getting an attorney is going to assist you into any prolonging of these complaints that are coming in. Then. by all means you know Mr. Chair I stand and support of this legislation and ask to be a co-sponsor of this you know to move this forward. So, I don't think he heard me, he was like he's stuck, but anyways Jesse good luck to you, you're on the right path. If there's any funding needed you know moving forward to make this happen you know, I'm sure you're going to come toward us. But, Mr. Chair, thank you so much for the opportunity and I don't know if you heard me but you know standing in full support of this legislation and asked to be a co-sponsor of the of the bill and hope that this legislation will not prolong any complaints coming to the Ethics Committee and hear them right away within 30 days the people of Guam should be able to know when a complaint comes in that you review it which is a legal perspective and in 30 days the people go and find out what's going on. So, I thank you for that, thank you Mr. Chair.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: And thank you Senator Telo and yes, when we get to Floor, I will highly request that the body accepts you as a co-sponsor. I know Senator Shelton asked me that privately, not a problem, Senator Brown, I'd like to also recognize Senator Moylan has joined us even though his phone is sideways but we'll work with that, Senator Brown ma'am.

Senator Joanne M. Brown: Thank you very much Mr. Chair, I don't have any questions I think it's pretty much a given as to the need for the Ethics Commission to have a legal counsel available as they as they review cases and you know ensure that they're getting the proper advice on how they proceed with such complaints that are brought before them. So, I have no questions to ask and we'll support the legislation thank you very much Mr. Chairman.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you Senator Brown and maybe I'll use the add all our colleagues to the bill and unless they object thank you.

Senator Joanne M. Brown: Yeah, just prioritize, you just prioritize your colleagues that shows up for your hearings.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Yes, I will.

Senator Joanne M. Brown: Thank you Mr. Chairman.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: I sure will, thank you, Senator Moylan, do you have any questions for the Ethics Commission for Mr. Quenga.

Senator James C. Moylan: No questions, I support the bill looking forward to them getting, getting the job done. So, thank you very much Mr. Chairman, thank you Mr. Quenga.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you very much, being that there's no one else to speak on the bill I guess this would be one of the quickest hearings we've had, well they will continue to receive testimony in case anyone wants to submit additional testimony to this. 

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Ethics Commission shall be an independent and autonomous entity within the Government of Guam with the authority to adjudicate complaints against government officials who may have violated the ethical code of conduct.
- I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds it is essential that the Guam Ethics
 Commission is supported by an independent counsel to adequately address such
 complaints against public officials in accordance with Chapter 15 of Title 4 Guam
 Code Annotated.
- I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to authorize the Commission to retain legal
 services in support of its operation in hearing and adjudicating ethics complaints
 against government of Guam officials.
- Section 2. § 15401(a) of Chapter 15, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby amended, to read:

"(8) The Commission may retain one (1) or more attorneys, who shall be admitted to practice before the courts of Guam, who shall advise the Commission and its Executive Director on all legal matters pertaining to the Commission. The designated counsel shall represent the Commission in litigation in which the Commission is interested or involved. The terms, conditions and compensation of employment of any such attorney shall be determined by the Commission, and the attorney shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Commission is authorized to pay for billable hours performed under the legal contract issued in Fiscal Year 2021 utilizing funds appropriated to the Guam Ethics Commission by the Guam Legislature in Fiscal Year 2022."

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

Bureau of Budget and Management Research Comments on Bill No. 205-36 (LS)

The proposed legislation intends to add a new Subsection (8) to § 15401(a) of Article 4, Chapter 15, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to authorizing the Guam Ethics Commission to retain legal services. Per information provided by the Commission, it is recognized that legal services are necessary for it to hear complaints of potential violations regarding Guam statutes on ethics. The Commission's enabling statute provided two options for legal services; first would be to request the services of the Office of the Attorney General (OAG), the second would be to recruit a staff attorney for the Commission full-time. The first option would place the Commission and its counsel at a conflict of interest for cases related to the OAG. The second would require the Commission dedicate a large sum of its total annual appropriation towards the recruitment of a full-time attorney. The anticipated cost for a full-time attorney would range between \$70,000 to \$120,000 annually with fringe benefits.

The Bill provides that the Commission may retain legal services under terms and conditions determined by the Commission. The average market cost for private counsel is \$200 per hour. Should the Commission secure counsel at this rate for a minimum of ten (10) hours a month for twelve (12) months, the anticipated cost would be \$24,000 per fiscal year. This is a feasible amount per the Commission.
