“RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING THE UTMOST SUPPORT OF *I MINA'TRENTAI SAIS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN* AND ADVOCATING FOR THE PASSAGE OF H.R. 928, “AMERICAN FAMILY ACT OF 2021”, INTRODUCED BY DELEGATE ROSA DELAURO, CONNECTICUT REPRESENTATIVE; WHICH SEEKS TO AMEND THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 TO MAKE THE CHILD TAX CREDIT FULLY REFUNDABLE, ESTABLISH AN INCREASED CHILD TAX CREDIT FOR YOUNG CHILDREN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

We, the **Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam**, are in support of Resolution No. 153-36 (LS), authored by Senator Telena Cruz Nelson. Res. No. 153-36 (LS), expresses the support of H.R. 928, the “American Family Act of 2021,” which seeks to modify the Child Tax Credit to be fully refundable, increase and allow for additional tax credit to dependents under six years of age, and to extend the Advanced Child Tax Credit payment indefinitely.

Through the American Rescue Plan of 2021 (ARP) funds, provision of these federal reimbursements, would allow the payments of the child tax credit to be available to Guam taxpayers, which would provide for much needed financial relief to our local working families. The Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation, allocates part of the general fund for the payments of tax credit. With the passage of H.R. 928, federal reimbursement would cover the Child Tax Credit payments making the local general fund available to local businesses and provide opportunities for operational funding and allowing for future economic growth of our island.
