However, it does not prohibit the offices of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor of Guam under the Executive Branch from utilizing the funds appropriated to their specific offices to fund the Guam Liaison Offices if they feel the office(s) are vital towards accomplishing their objectives and governance. It should be noted that the current budget appropriation under the Office of the Governor of Guam for the Guam Liaison Office in Washington, D.C. is \$204,231 for Fiscal Year 2021.
