The Bureau requests that Bill No. 219-36 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 219-36 (LS) is an act to amend subsection (a) and (b); and to add new subsection (g), all of §41210, Article 2, Chapter 4, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the certification of a disability as an impediment for individuals with disabilities.

The proposed legislation intends to amend the Department of Integrated Services for Individuals with Disabilities' (DISID) requirement to have a counselor from the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation certify an individual's physical or mental disability resulting in serious impediments to employment, and instead allow for such certification to be made by a Guam-licensed medical practitioner under "10 Guam Code Annotated (GCA), Chapter (Ch.) 12" to meet the two percent (2%) employment eligibility criteria relative to employment with the Government of Guam under the Rehabilitation Act.

Further, the proposed legislation removes DISID's responsibility to monitor compliance of the Rehabilitation Act by Government of Guam agencies and departments. The addition of subsection (g) and all of §41210 to Article 4, Ch. 41, Title 17, GCA shall require the Department of Administration to prepare and submit to *the I Maga'hågan Guåhan* and *the Speaker of the I Liheslaturan Guåhan* an annual report on the Disability Employment with the Government of Guam's agencies and departments 30 days after the end of Fiscal Year 2023 and annually thereafter.

Based on the forgoing, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon the Government of Guam.
