The Bureau requests that Bill No. 226-36(COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 226-36(COR) is an act to add a new § 715(p) to Chapter 7, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated relative to defining working days. According to the bill's legislative findings and intent, the terms "working days" and "business days" are not clearly defined despite widespread use in various public laws, the Guam Code Annotated, and the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations. Consequently, the proposed legislation seeks to establish "working days" and "business days" to mean Monday through Friday, unless such days are observed as Government of Guam Holidays.

This bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
