The Bureau requests that Bill No. 233-36(LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 233-36(LS) is an act to amend § 7.58(c) of Article 2, Chapter 7, Title 9 Guam Code Annotated relative to the expansion of the definition of mens rea (criminal intent) for crimes committing while intoxicated (alcohol/controlled substances). According to the bill's legislative findings and intent, the mens rea caps crimes committed while intoxicated at "reckless," which limits the criminal culpability of severe offenses like assault, criminal sexual assault or homicide. It is the Legislature's intent to remove defenses or limitations on these criminal offenses.

This bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
