

## Notes:

Upon the passage of Bill No. 228-36 (COR), any elected official(s) who is guilty of the provisions detailed in \$5107(c) to Chapter (Ch.) 5, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated (GCA) shall be subject to a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each violation, and these monies shall be deposited to the Better Public Service Fund, pursuant to Ch. 161 of Title 11, GCA. The Bureau estimates should there be one (1) up to ten (10) violations per fiscal year, revenues generated would be between five hundred dollars (\$500) to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per fiscal year.
