Comments:

1/ The proposed legislation is for the intent to adopt the implementation for payments of World War II claims as a result of the enactment of Public Law 36-62, with an appropriation of \$10 Million from the General Fund to the Department of Administration. As stated in Public Law 36-63, within thirty (30) days of enactment, the Governor will be required to transmit an implementable war claims payment plan to the Guam Legislature for adoption. The Bill's fiscal impact is consistent with the Bureau's prior fiscal notes for Bill Nos. 130-36 and 217-36, where it is estimated that there are at least seven hundred (700) individuals who could be positively impacted by provisions of the legislations. The measure should cost less than \$10 Million as the average war claim is approximately \$10,000.
