The Bureau requests that Bill No. 58-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 58-36 is seeking to amend section 2(b) of P.L. 34-112, which would extend the deadline for the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency to develop a functioning Customs Satellite Inspection, Holding, and Secured Sterile Facility Area increasing the time frame from three (3) to eight (8) years.

The proposed amendment is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact the appropriations for FY 2021.
