

1/The proposed legislation intends to add a new Article 4, Chapter 73, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to the establishment of a Interagency Working Group which would be charged with the development of a "Build-Lease-Transfer Plan" for the construction of a Customs Satellite Inspection, Holding, and Secured Sterile Facility Area and the procurement of a stationary X-Ray scanning portal. The bill would not have any major impact to the Government of Guam at this time. However, the Bureau notes, funding would need to be identified for the Guam Customs and Quarantine Agency (CQA) to pay for the lease of the Facility and Stationary X-Ray Scanning Portal. The legislation as is does not appear to have a negative impact to the Government of Guam at this time. However, the CQA may need financial support in the future for the aforementioned purposes.
