

### Comments:

Section 5 of Bill 51-36 cites that the Guam Football (Soccer) Association agrees to pay the annual rental sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per year to the GDOE, to be paid yearly in advance, commencing upon the effective date of the MOA and continuing on the 1st day of each year thereafter for the remainder of the MOA. The total revenue anticipated to be generated is thirty dollars (\$30.00) based on the MOA term of not to exceed thirty (30) years unless otherwise extended or amended. (\$1.00 per year x 30 years term = \$30.00)

### Bureau of Budget and Management Research Comments on Bill No. <u>51-36 (COR)</u>

Bill 51-36 will authorize the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) and the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Guam Football (Soccer) Association (GFA) for the use of real property described as a portion of Lot No. 3396 in the Municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago for a term not to exceed thirty (30) years. The property is to be utilized for the purpose of the construction and maintenance of soccer fields and related facilities.

The GWA has the administrative jurisdiction of Lot No. 3396 and the GDOE has administrative jurisdiction of the Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary School (OCPES) located adjacent to Lot No. 3396. It is noted that GWA is in the process of subdividing Lot No. 3396 to parcel out separate lots for GWA and GDOE, and the GFA wishes to enter into a MOA relating to GDOE's portion of the lot for the construction and maintenance of soccer fields and related facilities. Under the MOA, the GWA and GDOE agrees to place the subject property under the control of GFA. Any debt incurred and all costs associated with the construction and maintenance of the soccer fields and related facilities shall be at the expense of GFA.

Although requested by the Bureau, the GWA did not provide its official comments on the proposed measure as of the date of this fiscal note. According to information received from the GDOE, no fiscal impact is anticipated nor any physical impact by the GFA development to the OCPES property based on the proposed design. However, GDOE notes that in the event the property is subdivided, it may result in a reduction of property value.

Section 5 of Bill 51-36 provides for a symbolic annual rental sum of one dollar (\$1.00) per year to the GDOE, to be paid yearly in advance, commencing upon the effective date of the MOA and continuing on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each year thereafter for the remainder of the MOA. As such, based on this annual rental payment of \$1.00, the GDOE is anticipated to generate additional revenues of a total of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for the term of the MOA, unless otherwise extended or amended by the parties involved.
