Bureau of Budget and Management Research Comments on Bill No. 81-36 (COR)

The proposed legislation intends to amend Guam Code Annotated (GCA) relative to membership and voting on the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) Board of Directors. The proposed legislation will amend § 9112 of Article 1, Chapter 9, Division 1, Title 12 GCA to eliminate the authorization of GVB Contributing Members to acquire multiple voting rights on the basis of one vote for each annual contribution (not to exceed ten total annual contributions) of One Hundred Dollars (\$100).

Per correspondence with GVB, membership elections occur every two years, in which membership collections are deposited into GVB's Membership Fund ("Fund"). In FY19, there was a total of three hundred fifty-nine (359) contributing members, resulting in \$121.3K collected by the Fund in membership contributions. Applying the proposed legislation's amendment to only authorize one annual membership contribution (i.e. vote), the collection would have been \$35.9K in FY19, or a reduction of \$85.4K. In FY21, there was a total of three hundred seventy-nine (379) contributing members, resulting in \$120.4K collected by the Fund in membership contributions. Applying the proposed amendment would have resulted in the collection to have been \$37.9K, or a reduction of \$82.5K in FY21.

The Bureau notes that the Membership Fund is a non-appropriated fund source managed by GVB. As such, the amendment would not affect the revenues of the Tourist Attraction Fund, which provides funding to GVB for its operations every fiscal year. However, the Bureau notes that GVB will likely experience a reduction in revenues to its Membership Fund by an average estimate of \$83.9K on membership election years.
