The Bureau requests that Bill No. 89-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 89-36 is an act to amend § 4703(d)(1) and (2) of Chapter 4, Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated, which would increase the eligible transaction maximum threshold of the total cost to purchase a home on Guam under the First-time Homeowner Assistance Program from Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000).

As the Bill is administrative in nature, it poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam as the program is federally funded.
