Bureau of Budget & Management Research Comments on Bill No. 103-36 (COR)

1/: The intent of Bill No.103-36 (COR) is to limit potential exposure of patients and providers to COVID-19, preserve Guam's PPE and cleaning supplies, alleviate the patient caseload at Guam's healthcare institutions, and provide an avenue for insured patients to seek less costly medical care, to establish the authority and practice standards for telehealth and telemedicine services during public health emergencies in Guam by adding a new Chapter 29B to Division 2 of Title 22, Guam Code Annotated.

Chapter 29 B, Section 29302. Authority states, "The Department of Public Health and Social Services ("Department") is responsible for regulating all policies regarding telehealth and telemedicine services in Guam. The Guam Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") shall seek approval from the Department to practice telehealth and telemedicine services in Guam."

Per communication with DPHSS, the COVID-19 Telehealth program is already being funded for their Community Health Centers through the use of Federal funds. Any additional costs associated with the implementation of the Bill involve the formulation of regulations and policies regarding telehealth and telemedicine services on Guam. Although these costs should be minimal, absent any additional information from DPHSS, the Bureau cannot determine a fiscal impact at this time.
