The Bureau requests that Bill No. 106-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 106-36 is an act to add §§ 60109.1(1)(1)(I) and (J) to Chapter 60, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated, which would include police precincts and all other Government of Guam offices to the list of exceptions where an authorized individual shall not openly carry a firearm or carry a concealed firearm. Furthermore, the proposed legislation changes the violation for any person who knowingly and willfully violates any provision of this subsection to a misdemeanor from a petty misdemeanor.

As the Bill is administrative in nature, it poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
