Comments:

I/ The proposed legislation, to be known as the "Building Trust Act of 2021," intends to supplement the trust fund that is already in existence commensurate with Public Law 12-69 by ensuring that federal funding in the amount of \$300 million provided through the American Rescue Plan and pledged by the Governor be committed toward the construction of a new hospital. It will also allow the trust fund to receive funds from other sources, including appropriations from the Guam Legislature and private donations. Per GEDA, some of the Bill's provisions are counterintuitive to the Governor's authority and discretion with regards to the utilization of federal funds where legislative oversight is not required. Lastly, per local media sources, the GMHA has cited that a report from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers estimates the construction of a new hospital facility may cost up to \$743 million.
