1/: In its current form, the intent of the subject legislation is to address election-related timelines associated with the primary election, nomination petitions and voter registration. Should the Bill become law, the provisions would allow for more time for the Guam Election Commission to prepare for the General Election thereby potentially decreasing costs for salaries and overtime. The GEC is unable to provide more information but it should be noted that overtime cost incurred by the GEC averages approximately \$100K per year between FY2017 to FY2021 Year-To-Date.
