Bureau of Budget & Management Research Comments on Bill No. <u>194-36 (COR)</u>

Bill No. 194-36 amends § 14101 of Chapter 14, Division 4, Title 8 of the Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations (G.A.R.R.), and to repeal and reenact § 14102 of Chapter 14, Division 4, Title 8, G.A.R.R. relative to the Guam Invasive Species Inspection Fee (GISIFF) and its Assessment. The intent of the legislation is to update the Invasive Species Protection Fee in the manner as supported by the Port Authority of Guam Users Group and the Invasive Species Council by charging flat rates on all containers and passenger motor vehicles entering Guam and to additionally assess all materials and goods that may be carriers of invasive species.

Based on comments received from the Department of Agriculture (DOAg), the passage of Bill No. 194-36 will not create or add any undue costs to the department. They further add that the Bill would provide the revenue needed to hire personnel and increase capacity in the agency's effort to combat invasive species and protect the land.

Utilizing collection data for the GISIFF obtained from the FY20 Special Revenue Fund Report along with cargo information from the FY20 Tonnage and Container report retrieved from the Port Authority of Guam's website, a preliminary comparison was made between the FY20 GISIFF fees collected under the current law and the potential collections to be made should Bill No. 194-36 become enacted. See table below:

The above comparison shows a potential increase in GISIFF collections of \$619,990 should the fees proposed in the Bill be applied, compared to the actual FY20 GISIFF fees collected based on the current law. It should be noted that the above difference assumes all imported cargo inspections are performed in accordance with all inspection rules and regulations.
