

Is there a federal mandate to establish the program/agency?

1/ It shoud be noted that the proposed legislation does not identify a specific funding source to fund the procurement of a newly adopted Guam World War II Memorial Flag. Per comments provided by the Office of the Governor of Guam, the cost per flag is \$170. If there are approximately 128 government facilities that would be mandated to purchase a flag, the cost impact is estimated at \$21,760.
