1/: In its current form, the intent of the subject legislation is to modernize the initiative process, to provide Guam voters a reasonable opportunity to actively participate in the legislative process. While the amendments to the Bill are primarily administrative in nature, the Bureau questions the need to amend § 16220 of Chapter 16, Title 3 GCA, as there is already a fourteen (14) day timeframe for the Bureau to provide fiscal comments pursuant to § 9105 of Chapter 9, Title 2 GCA. Additionally, should the legislation move forward, the language in the Bill should be amended to be clear as to how the proponent is to officially notify the Bureau given the 30-day time limit to provide a fiscal impact statement or waiver thereof. Lastly, the Bureau would like to note that requested fiscal comments were not received from the Guam Election Commission to date.
