The Bureau requests that Bill No. 267-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 267-36 is an act to amend § 13103 and § 13104 all of Article 1, Chapter 13, Division 1 of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated and to amend § 2121 to Article 1, Chapter 2 of Title 28, Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations relative to establishing a fair process resolving ratepayer disputes. Based on fiscal comments received from Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA), they believe there is little to no financial impact to GWA for the changes proposed in the Bill.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
