The Bureau requests that Bill No. 287-36 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 287-36 (LS) is "An Act to Add a New § 4124(b)(2) to Chapter 4 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated, relative to Creating and Exemption from the Service Learning Graduation Requirement for all High School Students enrolled during School Year 2021-2022."

The Bill intends to address the current service learning requirement that high school seniors need in order to graduate by providing an exemption for all high school students enrolled during School Year 2021-2022. Because of the continued impact of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, many students could not actively participate in organized service activities. Without the exemption to this requirement, the student's ability to graduate maybe delayed and would adversely impact deadlines for attending college. A previous exemption to this requirement was provided for all high school students enrolled during School Year 2019-2020.

Bill 287-36 is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
