Footnote:

1/ The amendments in the proposed legislation remove the authorization for the Chief of Police to use volunteers to patrol the school campuses of the Guam Department of Education during non-school hours and authorizes volunteers to issue summons, notices to appear, citations, and notices of violation for offenses, as well as impound animals. Further, the Bill requires any volunteers recruited by the Chief of Police to clear a background check and complete a course of instruction and training, including other certifications mandated by law. The Bill does not state who will incur the costs for the course of instruction and training, along with other mandated certifications. The estimated costs for the course of instruction and training and certifications cannot be determined at this time absent information from the Guam Police Department.
