1/: In its current form, the subject legislation proposes to appropriate Six Hundred Nine Thousand (\$609,000) from the General Fund (GF) to the GEC for the purpose of conducting the 2022 Primary Election and early In-Office voting. As indicated above, all FY2022 GF adopted revenues have been fully-appropriated per P.L. 36-54 (FY2022 Budget Act). The proposed legislation does not provide language to offset the proposed appropriation with language to de-appropriate funds from another source. This would result in a variance of \$609K between GF revenues and appropriations. While the GEC is in support of the Bill, it has not indicated whether or not the amount is sufficient to fund the said election and in-office voting.
