## Notes:

The proposed legislation intends to transfer Lot No. 2417-1-R7, formerly known as the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) Central Headquarters, from DPHSS to the Guam Community College (GCC) for the purpose of developing and constructing a nursing annex for GCC to house its nursing and other allied health educational programs. If said property is used for other purposes, it shall revert automatically to the Government of Guam. The proposed legislation did not specify a funding source for the development and construction of the nursing annex.

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According to GCC, the proposed legislation will allow for the further expansion of its nursing and allied health programs. In terms of its fiscal impact, GCC stated that the transfer of the subject property will result in an increase in the college's assets. If enacted and the land is transferred, GCC will conduct its assessment on the programs to be supported in the proposed location and will explore all funding and financing options relative to the development and construction of the facility.
