The Bureau requests that Bill No. 300-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

(LS)

Bill 300-36 (COR) is an Act to repeal and reenact §5213 of Subarticle B, Article 3, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to strengthening the requirements of small purchases.

The proposed legislation stipulates that procurement of supplies or services not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for construction shall include a minimum of three (3) positive quotations from qualified sources. Additionally, a "no quote" quotation will not be considered a positive quotation but shall still be part of the procurement record. The procuring agency shall provide an attestation containing the record of businesses that were contacted and whether they submitted a "no quote", positive quotation, or didn't respond to the solicitation. Further, the procuring agency shall document the solicitation efforts to obtain quotations from qualified sources as well as provide the General Services Agency's list of qualified vendors for the item(s) or service(s) being procured.

Should the minimum of three (3) positive quotations not be obtained by the procuring agency, the procuring agency may proceed with the small purchase procurement as long as the attestation noted above has been completed.

Lastly, the Chief Procurement Officer, Director of the Department of Public Works, the head of an agency, or any designated procurement officer utilizing the subject procurement authority shall submit a quarterly report of all small purchases to the Guam Legislature.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
