

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 312-36(COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 312-36(COR) is an act to amend §40105(a) of Chapter 40, Title 7 of the Guam Code Annotated (GCA), relative to expanding necessary protections for victims of abuse to maintain the safety and basic needs off the victim or the minor child or children in common with the defendant.

Per correspondence with the Judiciary of Guam (Judiciary), there is no anticipated fiscal impact on the Judiciary, based on the proposed legislation set forth in Bill 312-36 (COR). As such, this bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
