Even with expanded use in modern times of personal devices and online material at home or in our schools, public libraries remain a critical resource to communities, serving as a central repository of important educational print and digital resources that our people can access conveniently and without cost. For these reasons, it is important that our libraries are empowered to upgrade and expand their catalogs with material that is responsive to the needs of their users. Bill Nos. 354-36 and 355-36, now known as Public Law Nos. 36-132 and 36-133, respectively, will enable the Guam Public Library to refresh its collection as needed, by simplifying the applicable procurement process.

Authorizing the Guam Public Library to modernize its collection and operations on a periodic basis will ensure the digital divide in our community does not limit the ability of our less resourced citizens to fully participate in our society today, or undermine their potential to improve their circumstances in the future. It is for this reason that I am signing Bill No. 354-36 and Bill No. 355-36 into law as *Public Law 36-132* and *Public Law 36-133*, respectively.

AN ACT TO AMEND § 5007 OF SUBARTICLE A, ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AMENDING THE EXEMPTION TO THE POLICY AGAINST ADVANCED PAYMENTS TO INCLUDE THE GUAM PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the Guam Public Library System plays an important role in our community as
- 4 gateways to information and culture that provides opportunities for learning and

literacy advancement and that facilitates new ideas that support innovation, creativity, and self-actualization.

ILiheslatura further finds that it is important that modernization of our library system requires procurement of the latest books, journals, research databases, and access to digital publications; and many of the providers are off-island vendors that do not accept Government of Guam purchase orders and require advance payment before its provision of goods or services.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan, therefore, intends to provide the Guam Public Library System with greater flexibility to expeditiously acquire the tools they need to expand its offerings to the community, and to authorize the use of advanced payment for the procurement only for library books, e-books, audiobooks, digital publications, newsletters, software, and any other publications deemed necessary.

Section 2. § 5007 of Subarticle A, Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"§ 5007. Policy Against Advance Payments.

With the exception of off-island orders of the Guam Public Library System, the Department of Education, and the University of Guam, no procurement shall be made under this Chapter which shall require advance payment."

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
