Buenas yan Hafa Adai Madame Speaker!

Bill No. 38-36 seeks to impose a personal fine against the director of a member-agency of the Application Review Committee (ARC), which is tasked with preparing and submitting to the Department of Land Management reports or position statements detailing findings regarding the impact certain land uses would have on their affected municipalities, in the event such reports or position statements are not submitted within the statutory timeline. For the reasons stated herein, and consistent with my prior statement on a similar measure, Bill No. 7-35, I veto this bill.

The position statements submitted by the ARC are a critical component of our Zoning statutory scheme, the primary purpose of which is to promote the public health, safety and general welfare of our communities by ensuring appropriate land use. While the business interest in ensuring timely delivery of these reports and position statements is understandable, such interests cannot be prioritized over the interest in ensuring the ARC prepares thorough reports. It does not serve the needs of the community to pressure directors to perform stunted investigations or submit rushed reports in the interest of ushering private interests through the zoning process.

As it is in many cases, expediency must yield to accuracy, even if it takes a little longer.

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1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 61106(b) of Article 1, Chapter 61, Division 2, Title 21, Guam
Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

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"(b) In any land use action that requires the review and decision by the Guam Land Use Commission, no municipal public hearing shall be scheduled

and conducted in the affected municipality until any and all available reports and
 position statements have been received from the Department of Land
 Management. Said reports and position statements shall be provided by the
 Application Review Committee within forty-five (45) calendar days from the
 filing of the application.

6 A member-agency of the Application Review Committee requiring 7 additional time to submit its respective report or position statement shall obtain written approval no later than ten (10) working days prior to the forty-five (45)-8 day deadline from the Chairperson of the Application Review Committee. The 9 10 additional time shall not exceed a period of fourteen (14) working days. A second 11 extension may be granted with written approval from the Chairperson of the 12 Application Review Committee for a period not to exceed an additional fourteen (14) working days. The director of a member-agency who fails to submit a 13 required report or position statement within the timeline stipulated herein shall 14 15 pay an administrative fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

16The administrative fine shall be a personal expense for the director of the17member-agency of the Application Review Committee and in no way shall the18fine be paid by an agency or the government of Guam. All administrative fines19imposed pursuant to this Subsection shall be paid to the Treasurer of Guam and20deposited in the Land Survey Revolving Fund established in 21 GCA § 60602.

Upon receipt of any report or position statement submitted by the
 Application Review Committee the Department of Land Management shall
 transmit said documents to the Mayor of the affected municipality."

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
