1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: Section 1. A new §96106 of Chapter 96, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, 2 3 is hereby *added* to read: 4 **"§ 96106.** Requiring the Availability of Automated External **Defibrillators in All Government Offices.** 5 Each Department and Agency of the Government of 6 Guam, inclusive of autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies which 7 has an office that provides a service to the general community of Guam 8 9 shall provide access to an automated external defibrillator AED. The 10 AED shall be available during hours that the government offices are 11 open to the public. Each Department or Agency may create the

18	without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this				
19	Act are severable.
