

AN ACT TO AMEND § 9112 OF CHAPTER 9, TITLE 3, GUAM CODE, RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF ELECTIONEERING AT POLLING PLACES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 9112 of Chapter 9, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated is *amended* to read as follows:

"§ 9112. Electioneering at Polling Place Prohibited.

No person shall do any electioneering on election day within one hundred (100) feet of any entrance and/or exit of any polling place. In the case of a school, the entrance is hereby defined as the entrance gate, if the school is fenced. The Commission may, on a case-by-case basis and limited to the election then forthcoming, create an exception to this Section through resolution in order to safely conduct the election. Notices identifying the newly set perimeter also shall be clearly posted at the polling place(s) affected.

The Commission shall be responsible for determining and marking the one hundred (100) feet or other boundaries under this section. Upon request of the Commission or any election official present at the polling place, the Guam Police Department shall promptly assist in the enforcement of this Section."

- Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately upon enactment.
- Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
