## AN ACT TO AMEND § 3102.3 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF OFFICE FOR BOARD MEMBERS OF THE GUAM BOARD OF EDUCATION.

1	<b>BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:</b>
2	Section 1. § 3102.3 of Chapter 3, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
3	amended to read:
4	"The Board shall be composed and serve terms as follows:
5	(a) Three (3) Appointed Voting Members. <i>I Maga'lahi <u>I Maga'håga</u></i> shall
6	appoint, subject to the advice and consent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, one (1) voting
7	member from among each of the following to serve for a term of three (3) years:
8	(1) one (1) member who is employed in an upper level managerial
9	position in a private business;
10	(2) one (1) member who is a parent of a student enrolled within the
11	Guam Department of Education; and
12	(3) one (1) member who is a retired teacher or administrator of the
13	Guam Department of Education.
14	(b) <u>SixFive</u> (65) Elected Voting Members. <u>SixFive</u> (65) voting members shall
15	be elected at-large at each General Election. Each elected voting member shall serve
16	for a term of twofour (24) years, commencing at 12:00 noon on the first Monday in

January following their election. A candidate for the Board must be at least twenty five (25) years old, and a resident of Guam for at least five (5) years immediately
 proceeding the date on which the member takes office and continuing throughout
 the term.

5 (1) Nomination of candidates for election to the Board shall be made 6 by petition on forms prescribed by the Guam Election Commission (Commission) and initiated by the candidate. In order for a candidate's name 7 8 to be placed on the ballot for election to the Board, such petition must be signed by not less than one hundred fifty (150) persons registered to vote in 9 10 Guam and must be filed with the Commission no later than the first Monday 11 after a Primary Election, unless such date is a holiday, in which it shall be 12 filed the day following the holiday, or sixty (60) days prior to a Special Election. No defect in any nominating petition presented to the Commission 13 shall prevent the filing of another petition which is presented within the 14 15 allowed filing period.

16 (21) The election provided for within this Subsection (b) shall be non17 partisan, and no political party shall directly or indirectly sponsor, nominate
18 or endorse any of the candidates for such office.

19 (c) One (1) student voting member of the Board shall be elected by the Island-20 wide School Board of Governing Students. The student member shall be a junior 21 or a senior at a public high school and maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or above; and the student member shall receive service-learning credits for the service 22 23 hours on the Board; and (ed) Non-Voting Members. The Board shall have the following non-voting 24 25 members serving a term of one (1) year: 26 (1)one (1) student voting member of the Board shall be elected by an

26(1)one (1) student voting member of the Board shall be elected by an27Island-wide School Board of Governing Students. The student member shall

1	be a junior or a senior at a public high school and maintain a grade point
2	average of 2.5 or above; and the student member shall receive service-
3	learning credits for the service hours on the Board; and
4	$(2\underline{1})$ one (1) member appointed by the exclusive bargaining unit which
5	represents teachers and other employees within the Department.
6	(d2) Non-Voting Member of the Mayors Council of Guam. One (1)
7	member appointed by the Mayors Council of Guam who shall serve for a term
8	of two (2) years, or for the remaining term of the appointed Mayor, whichever
9	is longer.
10	(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, active employees of the
11	Guam Department of Education are not eligible to serve on the Board.
12	Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
13	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
14	any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall
15	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
16	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
17	severable.
