AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 58.61 TO CHAPTER 58 OF TITLE 9 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE USE OF ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES WITHIN DETENTION AND CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. § 58.61 Use of Alcohol and Controlled Substances.

(a) It is unlawful for a detainee or prisoner within a detention or correctional facility operated by the Guam Police Department or the Department of Corrections to use or be under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance.

(b) A detainee or prisoner who violates subsection (a) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a sentence of imprisonment for a period of no less than thirty (30) days, or by a fine of no less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by

1	both such minimum sentence of imprisonment and fine. Such sentence
2	shall be in addition to the sentence for which a prisoner is being
3	incarcerated.
4	Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect on the date of
5	enactment.
