AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW ARTICLE 26, CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ENDING MARIJUANA DRUG TESTING.

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1. A new Article 26 is added to Chapter 12 of Title 10, Guam Code
3	Annotated, to read:
4	"Article 26
5	Responsible Cannabis User Employment Protection Act
6	§ 122601. Short Title.
7	This Act shall be called the "Responsible Cannabis User Employment
8	Protection Act"
9	§ 122602. Ending Marijuana Drug Testing.
10	1) Unless required by federal law, no employer, landlord, college or
11	government agency shall require any person, as a condition of employment,
12	housing, education or government services, to participate in a blood, breath or
13	urine test for the detection of marijuana.
14	2) This prohibition against testing:

15	a) shall not prohibit law enforcement authorities from such
16	testing as part of an investigation into possible intoxication while
17	operating a vehicle; and
18	b) does not prohibit an employer, college or landlord from taking
19	action based on a person's behavior rather than test results."
20	Section 2. Effective date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
21	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to
22	any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity
23	shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
24	without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
25	Act is severable.
