AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §3134 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 17, **GUAM** CODE ANNOTATED **RELATIVE** TO TEMPORARY **OF GUAM** DEPARTMENT **EMPLOYMENT** OF **FACILITIES EDUCATION** RETIRED AND MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL.

#### 1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.**

#### 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam Department of Education 4 lacks facilities and maintenance personnel, which resulted in delipidated and 5 unsafe school environment for Guam's public-school students. During the 6 multiple oversight and public hearings relative to the Guam Department of 7 Education and the March 2023 Emergency Session of the Guam Legislature, 8 Acting Superintendent Judith T. Won Pat stated that GDOE needs facilities and 9 maintenance personnel to repair and maintain facilities and buildings of the 10 institution.

11 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to temporarily hire 12 retired Facilities and Maintenance personnel to provide safe, healthy, and clean 13 school buildings and facilities and to comply with the Every Child is Entitled to an 14 Adequate Public Education Act. Section 2. A new §3134 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated
 is hereby added to read:

# 3 "<u>§3134. Temporary Employment of Retired Facilities and Maintenance</u> 4 Personnel.

5 (a) Guam Department of Education (GDOE) may hire retired GDOE facilities 6 and maintenance personnel to support their Facilities and Maintenance 7 Division including but not limited to auto mechanic, building maintenance 8 supervisor, carpenter, clerk typist, electrician, equipment operator, facilities and maintenance manager, maintenance supervisor, painter, plumber, 9 10 plumber leader, plumber supervisor, program coordinator, refrigerator mechanic, safety administrator, storekeeper, trades helper, warehouse 11 12 supervisor, and welder; who are not eligible for Medicare Parts A & B, and 13 who shall remain covered under the Government of Guam Group Health 14 Insurance Program as a retired person, if a critical needs arises as a result of military activation of GDOE maintenance employees or absence due to a 15 16 long-term disability status which has been certified by a medical doctor. The 17 GDOE may exercise this hiring authority provided its authorized budget for 18 personnel is not exceeded. The retiree hired shall fill such a vacant position and shall be terminated when the incumbent returns from military service or 19 20 absence. Retirees shall be hired at a minimum of Step 1 for the position in 21 question and shall not receive sick and annual leave. Notwithstanding § 8121(a) of Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 4 GCA, retirees hired temporarily 22 23 pursuant to this Section may continue to receive retirement benefits. The 24 Superintendent of GDOE shall submit a report to I Liheslaturan Guåhan 25 every July 1 of the year, and again thirty (30) days after the end of the fiscal 26 year, of the number of retired employees hired pursuant to this Section, the

3	(1) A Certificate of Necessity shall be signed by the						
4	Superintendent and posted onto the GDOE Website;						
5	confirming that the employment of a retired facilities and

7	vacant position in order to comply with the Every Child is						
8	Entitled to an adequate Public Education Act.						
9	Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately.						
10	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any						
11	person or circumstances is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity						
12	shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect						

without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of thisAct are severable.
