Rivera (a retiree of the Guam Fire Department), Ralph T. Rivera (a retiree of the U.S. Air Force), Eloise R. Sanchez (a retiree of the Guam Department of Education), Pinky R. Brindejone (a local entrepreneur), and April R. Wolford (a federal contractor); and
