WHEREAS, Marie Manalisay Reyes Nelson ("Mrs. Nelson") was born to Jose Mendiola Reyes and Rita Manalisay (Reyes) Aglubat; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Nelson believed in the power of education and served in the Guam Public School System from 1968 until 1970 as a teacher at Barrigada Junior High School, Carbullido Elementary School, J.P. Torres Elementary School, and J.Q. San Miguel Elementary School, and from 1970 until 1974 as an Assistant Principal at J.P. Torres Elementary School, Carbullido Elementary School and Tamuning Elementary School, and from 1976 until 1988 as Principal at Carbullido Elementary School and *Agaña* Heights Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, wanting to continue her passion for education as she approached retirement, Mrs. Nelson researched franchises and discovered Sylvan Learning Inc., the leading provider of personal learning for students in grades K-12, and successfully opened Sylvan Learning of Guam in 1989 in *Hagåtña* with six (6) employees — four (4) teachers, an assistant and herself at the helm; and

WHEREAS, under Mrs. Nelson's direction the "*Sylvan Method*" fostered student academic achievement and students' academic success on Guam which led to the need and addition of another location opening in 1992 in *Dededo*, making it possible for students in Guam's northern villages to access the "*Sylvan Method*"; and

WHEREAS, when Typhoon Paka caused severe damage to Sylvan Learning of Guam's *Dededo* location forcing a consolidation of resources into its *Hagåtña* location, Mrs. Nelson continued to offer an alternative learning method to students with learning challenges until 2019 when she chose to retire once more; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Nelson's shared her involvement and belief in the "*Sylvan Method*" with her daughter, Crystal, who now carries on as the franchise owner with plans to continue serving the community and honoring her mother's vision to provide quality education to help students succeed in school and life in the years to come; now therefore, be it


